





Dear colleagues,

This letter is the first announcement of the 2015 Summer School on Micromechanics that will be organized in the framework of FP7 IRSES project TAMER (IRSES-GA-2013-610547). The school is planned from 3 to 13 June 2015 in Bezmiechowa near Rzeszow (Jasionka international airport).

The program of the school is oriented to needs of the postgraduate students and young scientists and includes three courses (14 academic hours each)

Fundamentals of Micromechanics (Prof. Igor SEVOSTIANOV, USA) Computational Micromechanics (Prof. Helmut BÖHM, Austria) Fundamentals of Materials Science (Dr. Jaroslav Kovačik, Slovakia)

and Research orientation workshop (30 academic hours) on scientific presentations. The workshop will include three master classes on:

Writing research papers for international journals,

Making oral presentations;

Making poster presentations.

The master classes will be supplemented by work in small groups. The resulting papers are planned to be published as a volume of the Proceedings of the Summer School.

To participate in the Summer School the applicants have to submit their CVs and 6-8 pages long paper that they are going to polish during the master classes. The number of the places in the School is limited by 30 and the applicants will be selected on the base of these documents.
